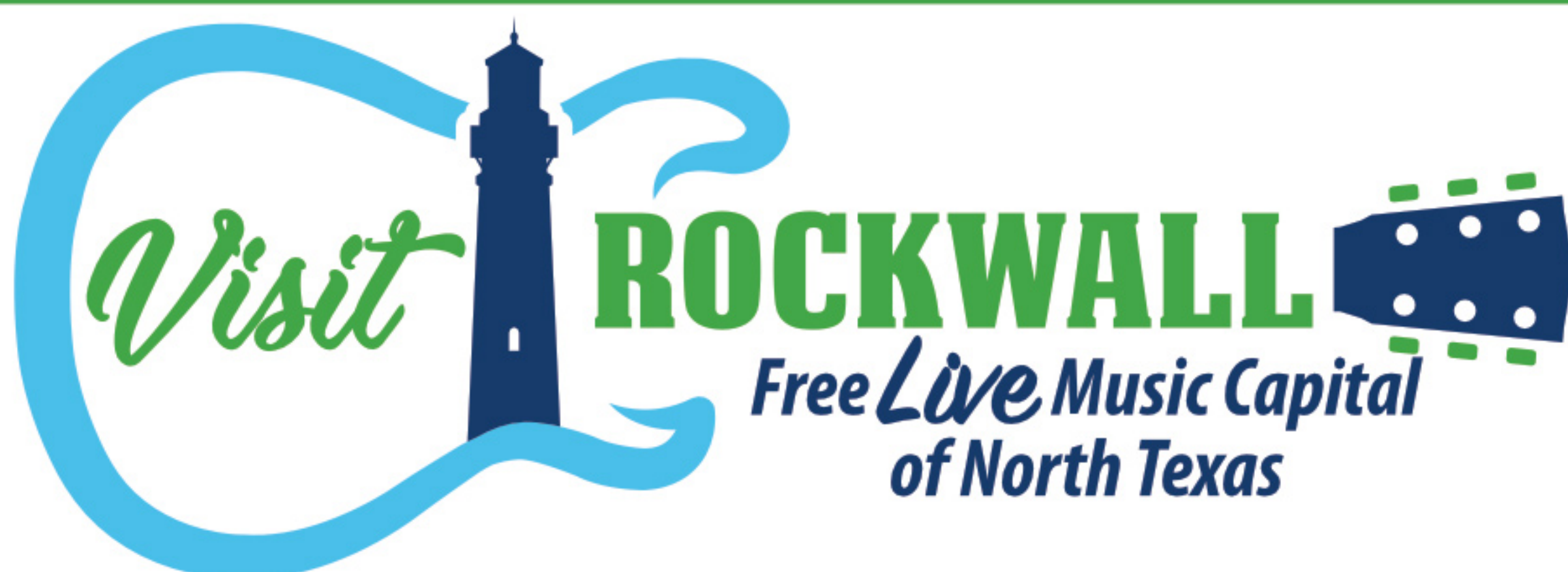

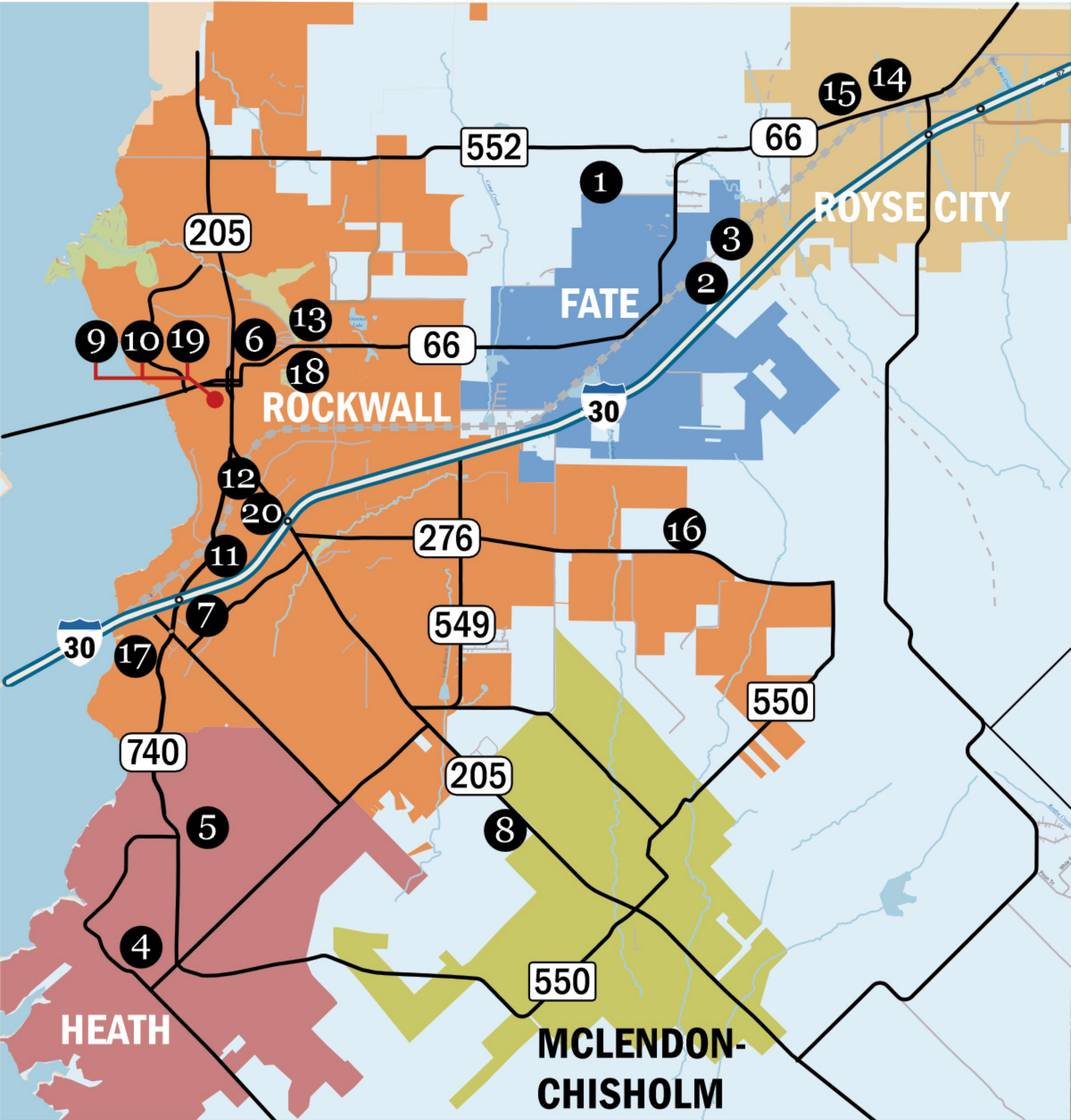

HISTORIC SITES AND MARKERS

- 1** Mount Zion Cemetery - 1.8 miles north of Fate on SH 66, then 2.3 miles west on FM 552 to cemetery on south side of road.
- 2** Fate Lodge No. 802, A.F. & A.M - 104 S. William E Crawford Ave.
- 3** Fate Presbyterian Church - 200 block of William E. Crawford Rd.
- 4** Sterling Rex Barnes - in front of Heath Cemetery at the corner of Smirl Dr. (FM 1140) & Terry Ln.
- 5** Heath Methodist Church - in the 100 block of Smirl Drive (FM 1140) near the southern intersection of FM 1140 and FM 740.
- 6** Rockwall County - Courthouse law (100 block of S. Goliad St. & 100 block of W. Rusk St.).
- 7** Central National Road of The Republic of Texas - Marker was located at junction of I-30 and FM 740 (southeast corner), Rockwall. Marker currently missing.
- 8** Chisholm Cemetery - on SH 205, 8 miles southeast of Rockwall (on west side of rd.) in McLendon-Chisholm.
- 9** East Trinity Lodge No. 157, A.F. & A.M - marker is just west of intersection of Rusk and Goliad streets on 100 block of Rusk (Lodge bldg. is at 104 S. Goliad), Rockwall.
- 10** First Baptist Church of Rockwall - 600 block of S. Goliad St. at the corner of S. Goliad and Boydston St.
- 11** First Presbyterian Church of Rockwall - 602 White hills Drive, Rockwall.
- 12** First United Methodist Church of Rockwall - 1408 S. Goliad (at the intersection of S. Goliad and Damascus Streets.).
- 13** Rockwall County - 950 Williams (8/10 mile north and east on SH 66).
- 14** First United Methodist Church of Royse City & FUMC Building - 701 Church St. (corner of Church and Josephine Streets) off SH 66.
- 15** Royse City Lodge No. 663, A.F. & A.M - 124 Arch Street (city hall).
- 16** Blackland Cemetery - Blackland Rd. north of E. Linda Ln.
- 17** Chandler Cemetery - FM 740 on south side of Henry Chandler Rd.
- 18** Rockwall County Historical Foundation Museum - 901 E. Washington.
- 19** Rockwall Memorial Cemetery - SH 66, one block west of Goliad Rd.
- 20** Rockwall Cemetery "Southside" - Highway 205, one mile north of I-30 on the west side of road.

HARBOR DISTRICT

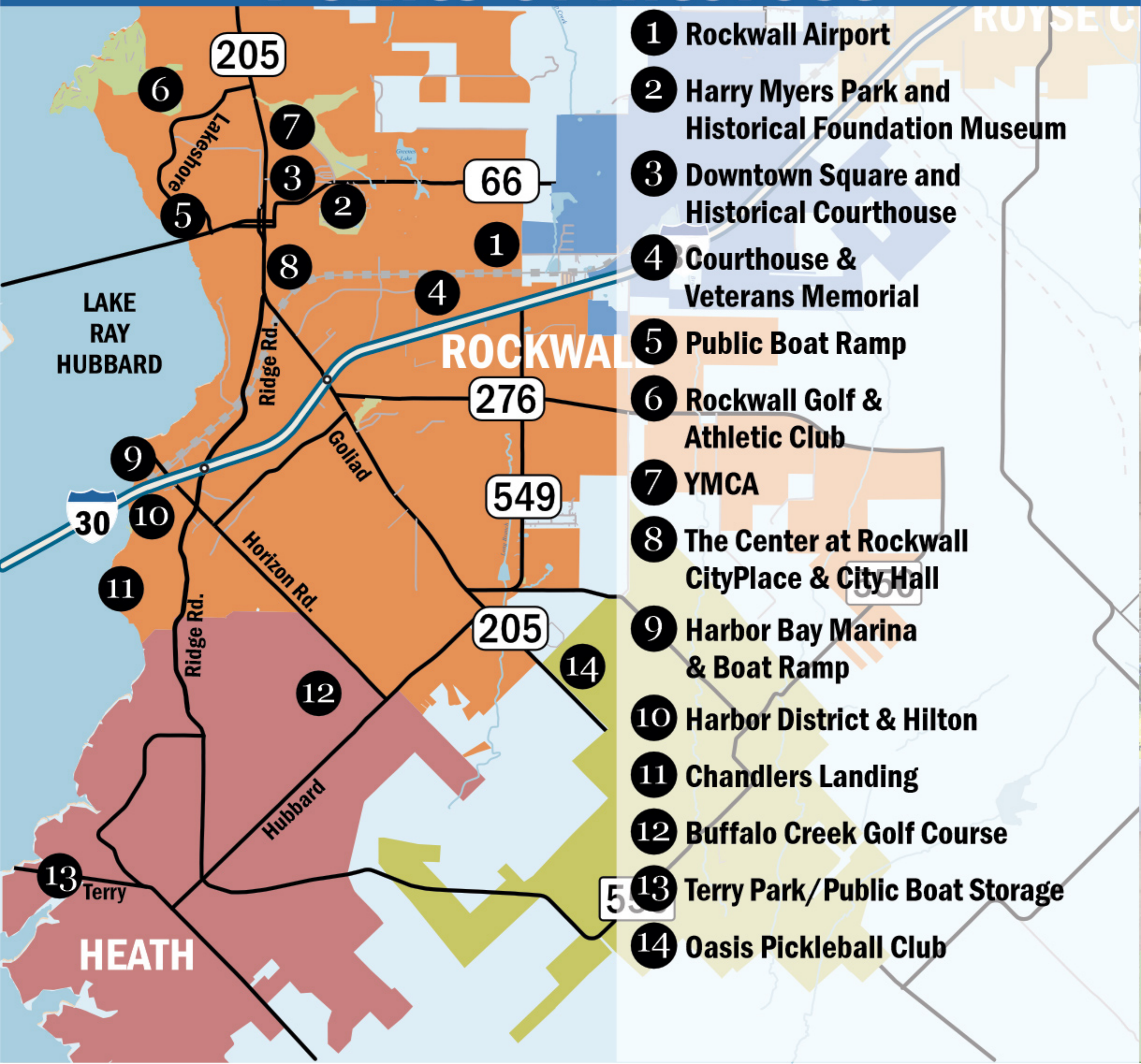

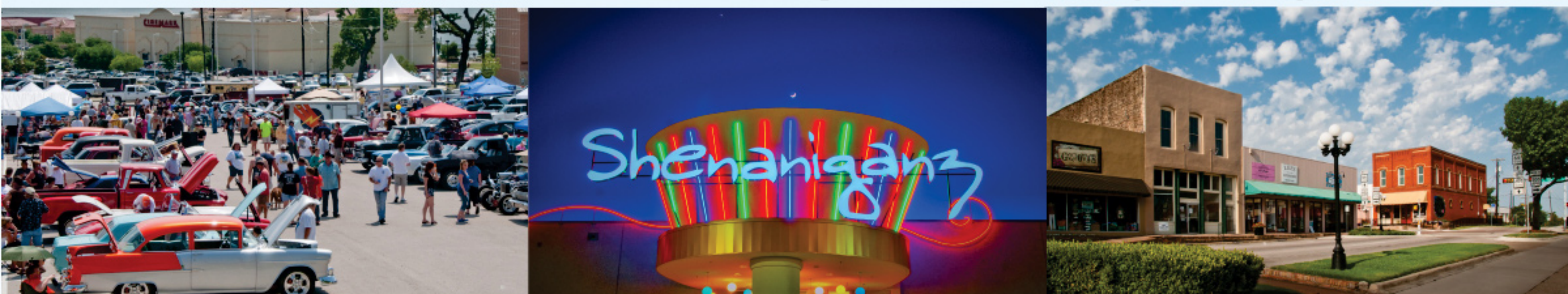
